Intensive Therapy Programs

Our intensive therapy programs are designed to improve functional goal areas through collaborative therapy techniques. Each intensive program includes comprehensive evaluations, individualized 1:1 therapy, parent consultation and a video home exercise program.

4-Week Program

◆ **Advance** This 4 hour per day, 5 days per week program is designed to improve functional strength and independence through gross and fine motor gains.

1-Week Programs

◆ **Advance** This is a condensed version of our 4-week program, that specifically targets a focused goal area.

◆ **Feeding** This OT/ST program utilizes a wide variety of feeding techniques including Sequential Oral Sensory (SOS) and The Get Permission Approach.

◆ **Apraxia** This speech based program targets the production of sounds, syllables and words.

◆ **AAC** A ST/OT based program that evaluates the most appropriate utilization of a communication system for your child.

◆ **mCIMT** Constraint Induced Movement Therapy is a unique program utilizing research based on neuroplasticity to increase strength, coordination and range of motion to the affected side.
